REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about May 6, 2019 the Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska. will submit a request to the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for the release of FY 18 Tribal Justice System Infrastructure Program funds under FY18(BJA - Tribal Assistance) Pub. L. No. 115-141, 132 Stat 348, 421 to undertake a project known as Halfway House Project for the purpose of razing and replacing the existing 110 year-old alcohol counseling and residential treatment facility known as the American Indian Human Resource Center and Chee-Woy-NaZhee Halfway House located at 203 Maple Street, Winnebago, NE 68071 with an estimated cost of \$1,808,644.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required.
