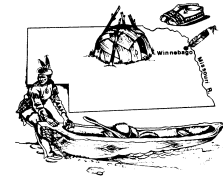




**Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska
Summer Youth Employment Program 2022
Guidelines**



Youth High School students between the ages of 14 – 19 years old (Up to 21 years for Disability/IEP, will be verified)

Enrolled in school on a full-time basis

Enrolled with the Winnebago Tribe of NE (Tribal SYEP)
(Must reside on the Winnebago Reservation)

Enrolled in a Federally Recognized Tribe (Social Services Program)
(Must live in the service areas Woodbury, Dakota, Thurston County)

Maintain a 2.5 GPA for the current academic school year (if an IEP on file, must provide proof)

Must not have more than 12 absences for the academic school year (Tribal SYEP)

All positions are classified as non-agricultural jobs, youth age 14 – 18 may be employed for non-hazardous positions. Youth age 14 – 15 are not allowed to operate mechanized equipment and youth age 16 – 18 may operate mechanized equipment under adult supervision.
