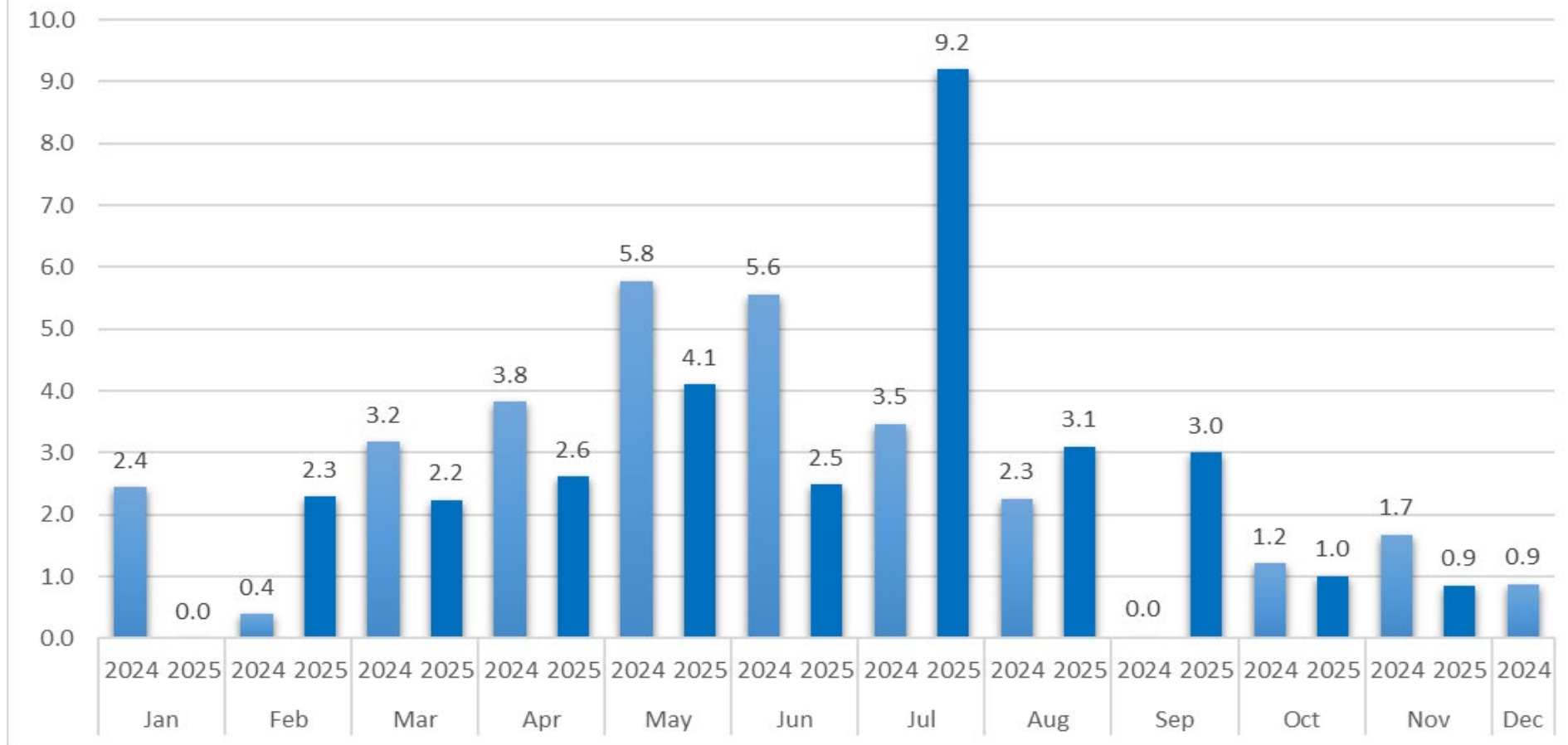


## WTN Precipitation (in)



This chart shows total monthly precipitation (rain and snow) collected at the Winnebago Tribe’s Mercury Deposition Network site in inches for 2024 and 2025. Bars compare each month side by side so you can see differences between the two years.

- Blue bars = inches of precipitation that month.
- 0.0 inches means no measurable rain or snow fell during that collection period.

Why precipitation matters: The amount of rain and snow directly affects how much mercury reaches our land, rivers, and lakes. More precipitation usually means more mercury is deposited, even if the amount in each drop stays about the same.

These data help the Tribe track patterns, understand mercury movement in our environment, and protect water and traditional resources. All samples follow National Atmospheric Deposition Program (NADP) standards.
