The Cultural Specialist will support tribal youth by integrating Ho-Chunk drum culture, traditions, and values into treatment services. This role includes participating in weekly treatment sessions, serving on the treatment team, advising on culturally appropriate care, and contributing to program planning and development.

Applicants must be knowledgeable in Ho-Chunk drum culture and able to share cultural teachings to support youth healing and growth.

Responsibilities also include completing required trainings, assisting with grant reporting, supporting youth progress, and maintaining awareness of behavioral health challenges affecting tribal youth and families, including substance use, trauma, depression, and suicide.

Pay: \$25/hour (up to 1,500 hours per year)

Duration: Grant-funded through September 30, 2028

Position contingent upon background check, pre-employment drug/alcohol screening, and other requirements. Selection does not guarantee a contract.
